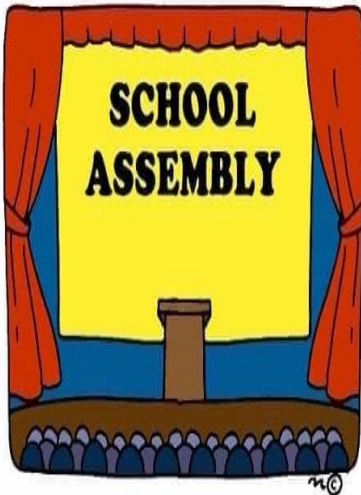

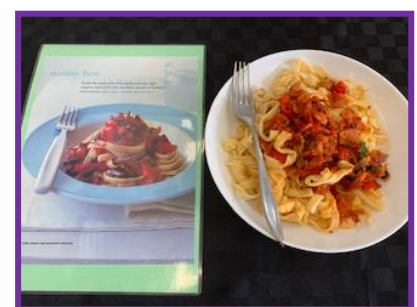

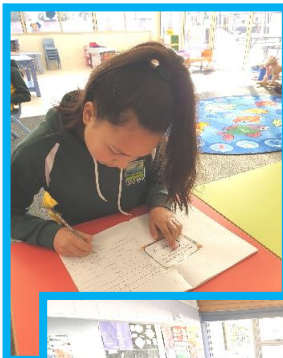


Grade 9/10 Foods: Food Presentation

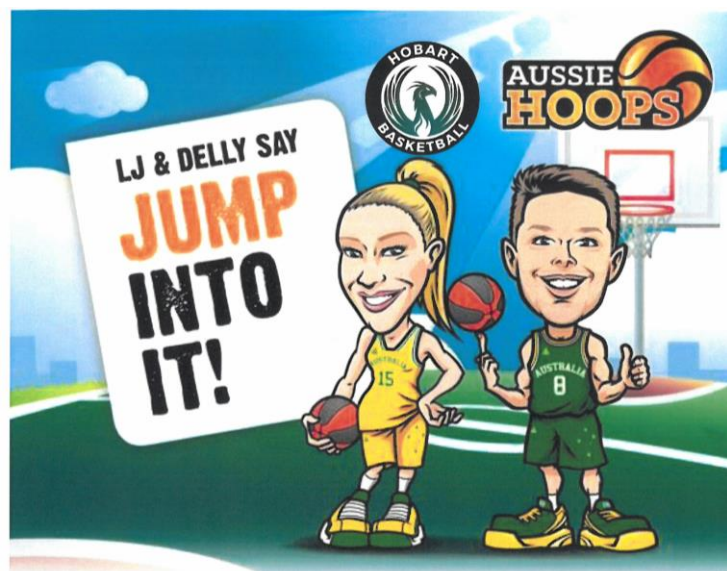
Pop Up Book Stall - Winter Opening Hours
