Walkathon - In Memory of Montana

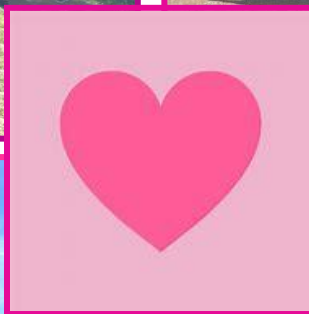
